## Notice and Opportunity to Comment

### CR 426 ENGLISH CROSSING BRIDGE AT MEDINA RIVER

#### From CR 462 English Crossing to Medina River Crossing

CSJs: 0915-47-039

#### Bandera County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Bandera County are proposing to replace the English Crossing CR 426 bridge crossing the Medina River in Bandera County, Texas. This notice is affording an opportunity to comment as part of the environmental review process for this project. You are receiving this notice because records indicate that you own property that would be acquired (in part or in whole) for this project.

The current low water crossing and culverts that CR 426 uses to cross the Medina River would be replaced with a bridge to allow the crossing to function during higher flow events. The new bridge would have a modified alignment requiring additional right of way from adjacent property and would be approximately 10ft higher than the existing crossing. The bridge would provide CR 426 with two 11ft lanes 5ft shoulders with a 6ft sidewalk and would utilize approximately 80ft of right of way.

Although additional right of way would be required, no residential or non-residential structures are anticipated to be displaced at this time. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (210) 615-6235.

Any environmental documentation or studies, maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at 4615 NW Loop 410 San Antonio, TX 78229, Phone 210-615-5846.
